Kuehne Logistics University (KLU) in Hamburg, Germany seeks applications from qualified candidates in logistics and transport, specifically in the area of maritime logistics, shipping and/or maritime economics for the position of Professor (Open Rank) of Maritime Logistics or Shipping Economics or Maritime Economics or Maritime Operations, beginning September 2021. This new faculty position at KLU in Hamburg will be embedded within the Hapag–Lloyd Center for Shipping and Global Logistics (CSGL). The position is a 6–year tenure track position if filled at the assistant level (or shorter if the applicant has had an appointment as assistant professor before), and a shorter tenure track for candidates at the associate and full level. In exceptional cases, hiring with tenure at the full level may be considered.

YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

The successful candidate will

- complement the research activity at the KLU with the objective of strengthening the institution's scientific reputation in this area,
- collaborate further with industry internationally and within the Hamburg Maritime Cluster,
- teach in KLU's study programs as well as develop and give programs in KLU Executive Education,
- contribute to institution building,
- acquire externally-funded research projects and build up a strong network within the industry and academia to apply for national and international research grants.

YOUR QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates should have a PhD in economics, logistics, management or engineering, with a demonstrable interest in liner shipping or container transport. Candidates with past experience in other related industries, such as aviation or international logistics, and a clear vision on how this can benefit maritime logistics are also strongly encouraged to apply

An understanding of the ports and terminals industry is beneficial although preference will be given to candidates with a focus on shipping and container shipping in particular. Although not a requirement, maritime industry experience and some knowledge of the German language would be an asset. Candidates should combine an understanding of relevant practical problems with inspiring teaching, a high potential in research and the willingness to contribute to institution building. Furthermore, candidates should be willing and able to teach a wide range of courses in our regular degree programs and in our executive education.

WE OFFER

Teaching load is attractive, with about three quarter-length courses as the nominal load, and may include teaching at the undergraduate, master and PhD level, as well as executive education. Language of instruction is English.
